



# Firefox


When this menu opens up click on the Add-ons icon (puzzle piece in the lower right corner of the menu)





Once the Add-on is installed Firefox will suggest restarting Firefox now, do that to enable this Add-on



After Firefox has restarted you'll see a button in the upper right corner of the browser window that looks like this:




This button will enable you to view and use LMAA within Firefox

# Firefox

- Go to SRDS.com (in Firefox) and click on the new button in the upper right corner. Login to SRDS.com as you normally would and click on the LMAA link.

# Chrome

- To get the Chrome extension that will allow LMAA to work within Chrome do one of the following:
